Monthly Activity and Community Policing Report – April 2022

Ptl. Sattler continues SRO duties and Sgt. Moore continues DARE instruction for EP schools.

The testing and interviews for full-time patrol have been completed. Anthony Monteleone has been hired as a dispatcher until he completes the police academy starting in August 2022. Chad Shaffer has accepted a conditional offer of employment and is in the hiring process.

Officers continue to receive training in an effort to meet the 24-hour CPT requirements for 2022.

Police, Fire and EMS participated in the mock crash for prom promise.

Members of the department worked with the Ohio State Patrol conducting criminal patrol – drug interdiction in the Village on April 30th. As a result, a total of 25 traffic stops were made throughout the evening to include:

- 4 K9 deployments, which resulted in the recovery of Marijuana, Drug Paraphernalia and suspected Cocaine.
- One individual was cited for OVI within the business district.
- Two individuals were cited for driving under suspension.
- In addition to several moving violations which resulted in citations, 14 drivers were issued warnings for minor traffic offenses and/or equipment violations.
