OCJS recruitment grant update: One applicant is enrolled in the CCCTC academy and the second applicant is enrolled in the winter YSU academy. Cierra Coontz was sworn in as a full-time officer on January 18th.

Officers completed 24 hours of annual training through OPOTA – training reimbursement funds were received.

The 2024 temporary holding facility inspection was submitted and approved by ODRC.

All officers tested on the Use of Force Policy and a supervisory review was completed for the recruiting and hiring process. We remain compliant with the Ohio Collaborative in these areas.
