Officers spent time on foot patrol in the business district.

Officers continue their mandated CPT through OPOTA.

Officers worked the 150th Anniversary providing traffic control and security for the daylong celebration. The Police Officers Association donated 250 Child ID kits to help parents record and safely store important identification information about their children.

The Drug Abuse Response Team (DART) grant was received. This funding will be used to offset the wages, overtime and the training of officers involved in peer support / crisis intervention. The officers work in collaboration with mental health and crisis response team members to assist those who are dealing with drug dependency and related mental health issues.
